Depending on your chosen route West you may be entering Builth Wells either on the A470 from Hay on Wye, from the A481 (A44) from Leominster, or A483 from the north or west of Wales.

Whichever way you will very likely come past Wyeside Arts Centre In Builth Wells on the bridge and a big mural on the end of a stone building at the bottom of the high street. Continue up the one way, narrow high street through Builth and follow the road round to the right at the top.

Continue out of Builth following signs for A483 in the direction of Llandovery and Carmarthen. Over the bridge, past entrance to Caerberis Hotel (which is on left). Continue on this road for a couple of miles until you enter the village of Cilmery. Turn right at the Prince Llewellyn Inn . Follow this road round for a couple of miles, it twists and turns. You will pass a small bungalow on your left, Cilmickney Farm (garden gnomes on the wall). Continue on for half a mile after this not taking any turnings (ignoring the satvnav if it wants to turn left), until the road enters a grove of trees (pines and larches), in the middle of the trees is a white finger post pointing left to "Erwneuadd". Take this turning and continue down this narrow lane for about 200 yards, it will open out into our courtyard, and we will be there to greet you.

The lovely neighbours at Cilmickney Farm which you pass, or Llys Mawr beyond us, will be able to give you directions to us if you have any trouble....
